Protocols: If COVID symptoms or past COVID or anyone in the house is covid or CPR – only two people are to respond. Windrows/Merwick allows one trainee or cadet. All other calls may be 4 person crews.

1000 & 5000 are limited to 2 person crews

2000 also limited crews

Fire protocols: be ready to standby because it is hot

we will stock water in the cabinet

ice and water provided by fire

Krishna: trustees had an insurance settlement on fridges and radio cabinet – after it was backed into and is available if we need a cabinet or fridge.

Make sure you talk to Plainsboro and Mercer County central. OIC call one and EMT2 talk to the other. ER1 which is channel 6. Make sure you introduce yourself as an ambulance.

We will be putting sprayer bottles on the trucks (.5 gallon mix with 1 fl oz of green disinfectant). Pump bottle and make fine mist meant to stay on surfaces. Will be kept in compartment with trauma bags. Don't supersaturate, but spray on anything, stretcher, padding, etc.
