- We are working to remediate this issue as follows:

- o Five EMT 2's actively training to be EMT 1s, and Two EMT 2's will soon be joining them based on the exposure they get over the next couple of months. It will undoubtedly add capacity to our current pool of Five regular OICs and Four part-time OICs. We expect a pipeline of 12 regular EMT 1 / OICs in the next 3 to 5 months.
- o Also, a strong pool of upcoming EMT 2's, including adults (9) and cadets (4)
- Please help as much as possible, especially with OIC openings, until we build the team.
 All our OICs and EMT 1's who are not actively riding, please help us until we get to a better place. Thanks! Every little thing will help reduce the stress and burnout in the existing group.
